

Fixed Route Fares

Your bus fare will depend on how many zones you travel through in order to get to your destination. Zones are listed below.

CHILDREN 11 AND UNDER RIDE FREE

Children ages 11 and under ride for free on Freedom Transit's fixed route buses when accompanied by an adult rider.

REDUCED FARE CARD

Reduced fare cards are available for eligible riders who can provide proof of disability or a Medicare Card. Applications are available at Washington Transit center or by calling 724-223-8747.



One zone: \$0.75

SENIORS RIDE FREE

Anyone 65 years of age or older can ride for free on any Freedom Transit fixed route bus. A PA Transit ID Card, available at Washington Transit Center or by calling 724-223-8747 and requesting an application, must be shown to the driver when boarding the bus to receive free fares. Proof of age must be included with the applications for a Senior ID Card.



TRANSFERS

Transfers are free when traveling within one zone. When transferring to a higher fare route you must pay the "up value" when boarding the second bus. If you need a transfer make sure to ask the driver for a slip before leaving the first bus. Hand the transfer slip and the "up value" (if needed) to the driver of the second bus for your fare to be accepted.

FREEDOM TRANSIT FIXED ROUTES

Local A, Local B, & Local Saturday routes: Washington local bus service to residential, shopping, dining, employment, medical, and entertainment locations.

County Line A & B routes: Service between Washington, Houston, Canonsburg, & McDonald as well as separate service between Washington, McMurray, Peters Township, Finleyville, and Monongahela with stops along Racetrack Road.

Pittsburgh Metro & Saturday Metro routes: Service between Washington, Houston, and Canonsburg with trips into Downtown Pittsburgh on weekdays and the South Hills on Saturdays.



Token Transit

Token Transit is a mobile ticketing app available for download on the App Store & Google Play. Digital Freedom Transit multi-pass options are available on the app, as are one-way tickets.

Token Transit passes and tickets can be purchased on the app or through the web portal at tokentransit.com.

When boarding a Freedom Transit fixed route bus open your Token Transit app and tap the pass option you would like to redeem for the trip. A "picture of the day" and scrolling time stamp will appear on your screen once the pass has been redeemed. Simply show this screen to the driver as you board and your fare will be deducted.

You have 30 minutes to board a Freedom Transit bus once the pass has been activated. Multiple pass options can be stored onto your Token Transit app at one time.



Riders who qualify for reduced fares must call Freedom Transit at 724-223-8747 in order to access the reduced fare options on the app.

OUTBOUND PITTSBURGH METRO RIDERS:

You will pay your fare as you disembark from the bus. Please refrain from tapping your ConnectCard against the card reader or redeeming a Token Transit pass until you have come to your final stop.

ConnectCard

ConnectCard is a reloadable smart card that allows you to store Freedom Transit bus passes and stored cash value to pay for your fixed route transit fare. ConnectCard products are available for purchase at Washington Transit Center, online at connectcard.org, and at ConnectCard machines in Downtown Pittsburgh including Port Authority's Downtown Service Center.



You can load a minimum of \$5 onto the card and a maximum of \$200. You are also able to store 1 pass option and up to \$200 cash onto the card at once.

When boarding a Freedom Transit fixed route bus tap your card against the orange card reader on the farebox to pay your fare. Fareboxes are programmed to redeem a bus pass before deducting stored cash value. Each rider must have their own ConnectCard, as the fare box will not allow for more than one tap from the same card for fare payment.



If you are purchasing passes or stored cash value online, please keep in mind that online sales may take up to 72 hours to appear on the card. You may check the balance of your card and register for balance protection online once you create an account on connectcard.org.
